



Liquor License Policy

Kalamunda Rangers Inc. provide a Club License for the purpose of enabling the Club to provide an additional service to its members. This liquor service is *ancillary* to the principal purposes of the Club.

As part of our compliance with the Liquor Control Act 1988 (the Act) in relation to the issuance of this license, the following terms shall apply:

In line with Section 121, juveniles are permitted to be on licensed premises for legitimate reasons such as:

- they are a member of a Club;
- where the premises is being used for a function;
- obtaining a meal;
- under the supervision of a responsible adult (parent, step-parent, spouse, de facto partner, legal guardian or person in loco parentis);
- as an employee in accordance with the requirements of the Act;
- Where the premises is being used for an underage event.

Kalamunda Rangers recognises that a significant proportion of our membership are juveniles, and should be able to utilise the facilities of the Clubrooms as needed. To enable this to occur, and still maintain compliance with the Act:

- a. No liquor shall be sold or supplied to any juvenile (i.e. any person under the age of 18 years). This applies to sending a juvenile for the purpose of obtaining liquor, supplying the juvenile with alcohol for consumption either via second party sales or with parental consent.
- b. Juveniles shall be able to approach the bar area for the purpose of obtaining food or non-alcoholic beverages only where no other service points are available.

In addition, in compliance with the Club Codes of Conduct and affiliated bodies' regulations, alcohol can only be sold for consumption in designated wet areas.

No liquor shall be sold or supplied for consumption elsewhere than on the Club premises.

No payment or part payment to any secretary, treasurer, manager or other officer or servant of the Club shall be made by way of commission or allowance from or upon receipts of the Club for liquor.

Sponsorship and advertising opportunities from the alcohol industry shall be permitted for senior teams only. There shall be no promotion of any alcohol product during Club events and functions.

Members may introduce guests to the Club at any time, provided that:

- No member may introduce more than five guests to the Club at any one time. A guest shall not be supplied with liquor in the Club premises except on the invitation and in the company of that member;
- A guest shall be supplied with liquor to be consumed on the Club premises only;
- The member introducing the guest shall be responsible for the proper conduct of that guest whilst on the Club premises;
- A member may, at their expense, and with the approval of the Club Committee, supply liquor to guests, without limitation as to number, at a function held by or on behalf of that member, at the Club premises; and
- Any person who has been refused membership of the Club or who is under suspension or expulsion from the Club, shall not be admitted as a guest of any member of the Club.
