Teeball Lightning Carnival Rules

Lightning Carnivals are great fun. Kalamunda Rangers recognises that not all our players will have the opportunity to play at Interdistrict carnivals and we would like to provide the opportunities for all our players to experience the enjoyment and challenge of participating in a Lightning Carnival event. As we do not play for 'championship' trophies throughout the season, this Carnival also provides opportunity for those players with the desire, to find out 'who won'.

This is expected to be an enjoyable day for the whole family and other activities will be provided to our members between games.

1. Teams from each age division may be divided into smaller groups of no more than five teams. No grading shall take place, and group allocation is at the sole discretion of the Teeball Registrar with reference to Saturday morning score slips.
2. Fixtures will be prepared by the Teeball Registrar and will only be available a few days before the carnival. Each team in our 8s, 10s and 12s divisions shall play four games of 30 minutes each, with a 40 minute break between games. 6 & Under teams will be playing one game only, with one team having the standard 'bye'.
3. Game rules are the same as Saturday morning games. All Local Club Rules and Codes of Conduct also apply at these games. No player shall occupy the same fielding position in the same game unless replacing an injured player. The same batting line up cannot be used from one game to the next; Batters should be rotated through the batting line up.
4. Bases and shelters shall be set up by the team named first in the earliest game of the day; bases and shelters shall be packed up and left at home plate by the team named first for the final game of the day.

Shelters shall be provided at the Carnival as per Saturday games, however there is only limited natural shelter available. Teams are encouraged to provide their own additional shelter for players in between games. Remember: slip, slop, slap, sip.

5. All teams having a bye will be rostered on to help out in the Canteen, BBQ and other activities.
6. The team listed first (home team) sits on first bag line and will field first, the away team sits on third bag line and will bat first. This is to avoid any delays in starting the games in working out who is going where.
7. All games last 30 minutes and shall start and finish on the siren. A two minute warning siren will be sounded prior to the start of each game and all players must be in place on the diamond ready for the starting siren.

Any play in progress when the final siren sounds shall be completed on the next Time call, and no further plays are permitted. At the completion of each game all teams must pack up quickly and move out of the dugout to allow the next team to set-up. There is only a 10 minute window for this to happen and your consideration is appreciated.

8. Speed-up rules apply to all games: One minute changeovers between digs, all players to move off the diamond quickly; batters and fielders to be ready when the Umpire calls 'batter up'
9. Only the team Coach may address the Umpire. Only the Team Coach can ask for 'Time' and that can only be when a player is injured or a player's or spectator's safety is at risk. 'Official' or 'Umpire' shirts must not be worn when coaching a team.
10. Spectators are asked to remember the Four Fs of Teeball – Fun, Fair Play, Fundamental Skills and Family Involvement. Please note: This is a **smoke and alcohol free** carnival.
11. All games should be scored in back pages of the team's Scorebook. Final scores revert back to **last completed innings**.
12. Please ensure **ALL** your score slips are completed – front and back – and returned to the Score Slips box located near the Canteen **as soon as your game finishes**. All games go towards the players' personal game counts.
13. The winning team for each group will be calculated on the number of wins and, if necessary, percentage.
14. All teams are required to attend the presentation to be held at 2:00pm.
