## **UNIFORM POLICY**

Uniforms promote a sense of community, a sense of belonging, amongst our members both within and as a representative of our Club in the wider Teeball, Softball and Baseball community. As a player and representative of the Club, players are required to wear the correct uniform at all times. Uniforms should be in good repair and demonstrate a sense of pride and respect for the Club.

The Club Colours shall be black, gold/yellow, white and silver/grey, with additional colours to be included as the Club deems necessary.

All articles of clothing bearing the Kalamunda Rangers names and/or logos shall be supplied through the Club and its recognised suppliers.

1. Club Uniforms shall be:

Biz Collection Bizcool<sup>TM</sup> Splice polo shirt in black with gold trim and embroidered with the Kalamunda Rangers logo in silver & gold on the left breast.

This shirt may also be utilised as the Teeball Interdistrict Participation shirt and printed with the Team details on the back in gold print.

The front of the shirt shall not be modified in any way.

- 2. Baseball uniforms shall be:
  - a. White pants with a black belt
    - i. Machine Pitch and Minor Little League can wear white or grey pants with a black belt
    - ii. Junior Girls and Women's division to wear black pants with a yellow belt.
  - b. black warm-up teeshirt with the word Rangers printed across the front in gold using Brushscript MT font with tail.
  - c. Playing shirts will be black with gold sleeves with a black-and-white stripe across each sleeve and a black-and-white trim around the collar and parallel down the front to the waistband. The logo word "Rangers" usung Brushscript MT font across the chest with a number underneath and a large number on the back, all in gold.
    - i. Teams participating in the same competition shall be differentiated from each other with variations in the colour distribution, with the body of the game vest being white or gold or grey/silver. Additional colours may be added as needed and with approval from the Committee
  - d. black hat with KR embroidered in silver/grey and gold thread on the cap; and
  - e. black socks.
  - f. Machine pitch playing shirts may be coloured outside regular branding colours. All designs to hve black sleeves with the main colour trim and logoword "Rangers" using Brushscript MT font on the front across the chest.
  - g. The warm-up shirts may have a sponsor's details printed on the back and/or left sleeve; the right sleeve shall be reserved for GrandSlam Club Sponsor details. The team sponsor may have their logo printed on the back of the white game vests underneath the number subject to sponsorship agreements.

- h. Any changes to the design of the Baseball uniforms shall be approved, by Baseball WA. Any modifications to these uniforms must be approved by Baseball WA prior to their implementation.
- 3. *Softball* open competition uniforms shall be:
  - a. black sublimated shorts or black pants with a black belt or black shorts to be not shorter than the clubapproved sublimated shorts;
  - Sublimated fitted polo, gold at the shoulder fading to black at the waistband, black collar and with the word Rangers in black across the front using Brushscript MT font with tail and a large number in gold on the back. The sponsor may have their logo printed on the sleeve or back of the game shirt underneath the number, subject to sponsorship agreements;
  - c. black hat with KR embroidered in silver/grey and gold thread on the cap or black visor with the word Rangers embroidered in gold across the peak using Brushscript MT font with tail; and
  - d. black socks or black Club socks with the word Rangers knitted down the outside.
- 4. *Winter softball* uniforms shall be:
  - a. Black or white pants or shorts (all team player shall wear the same colour)
  - b. Black teeshirt with gold Rangers across the front using Brushscript MT font with tail and a large number in gold on the back.
  - c. Black hat with KR embroidered in silver/grey and gold thread on the cap.
- 5. Social Mixed Softball (in-house) uniforms shall be:
  - a. collared polo shirt with the word Rangers printed across the front using Brushscript MT font with tail and any sponsors details/logo on the back. Team Shirt colours should differentiate between teams playing within the Club;
  - b. grey or black pants;
  - c. black hat with KR embroidered in silver/grey and gold thread on the cap; and
  - d. black socks or black Club socks with the word Rangers knitted down the outside.
- 6. *Teeball* uniforms shall be:
  - a. Aussie Spirit Tasman polo, printed with Kalamunda Rangers logo on the left breast, the word Rangers across the front using Brushscript MT font. As Teeball is played at home only, the Team Shirts should differentiate between teams playing within each division. Team Sponsors are able to choose from the available colour combinations.
  - b. grey full-length pants;
  - c. black hat with KR embroidered in silver/grey and gold thread on the cap; and
  - d. black socks or black Club socks with the word Rangers knitted down the outside.
- 7. Interdistrict Teeball uniforms shall be:
  - a. grey full length pants;
  - b. Black shirt with gold pinstripes going vertically down the shirt front and back, with gold sleeves with the sponsors logo on them in a baseball style shirt with button all the way down the front. Rangers in Brushscript font with a tail in gold print across the front. Surname on the back in gold print. Whole team listed in a black box on the back with gold print.
  - c. black hat with KR embroidered in silver/grey and gold thread on the cap; and
  - d. black socks or black Club socks with the word Rangers knitted down the outside.
- 8. Other
  - a. Junior Baseball game shirts shall be purchased by the Club. Senior Baseball game shirts shall be purchased by the players. Players have the option of reserving a specific uniform number number until they are cleared to a different club, release the number to the committee and/or have not registered for baseball in 2 subsequent

seasons; to ensure numbers are held in reserve for subsequent season/s players must register by 31 August each season.

- b. Softball game shirts shall be purchased by the players. Players have the option of reserving a specific uniform number number until they are cleared to a different club, release the number to the committee and/or have not registered for baseball in 2 subsequent seasons; to ensure numbers are held in reserve for subsequent season/s players must register by 31 August each season.
- c. Teeball game shirts shall be purchased by the Club which will be loaned out to players.
- d. Interdistrict Teeball shirts shall be purchased by the players.
- e. Due to the considerable expense in providing uniform shirt, players are required to take all reasonable care and return all club-provided uniform shirts in good condition, at the end of the playing season. The player shall be responsible for any costs incurred in the repair/replacement of damaged uniforms. Interdistrict Teeball shirts shall be purchased by the players.
- f. Current replacement costs (1 shirt only)
  - i. Baseball game shirt \$150.00
  - ii. Teeball game shirt \$25.00
  - iii. Softball open game shirt \$100.00
- g. Players are required to provide their own pants, warmup shirts, hats, and accessories in accordance with the Club Uniform.
- h. Club uniforms shall not be altered in any way unless by majority decision at a Club Committee Meeting.
- i. In order to maintain a consistent standard, Club uniforms shall only be sourced through a supplier approved by the Club Committee.
- j. The safety of our players is paramount. To ensure the safety of our players:
  - i. all game shirts should be tucked into the waistband of the uniform pants;
  - ii. no pins or badges shall be attached to any part of the uniform;
  - iii. there shall be no bare skin exposed below the waist.
- k. Failure to comply with the uniform requirements shall result in disqualification from games until such time as compliance is attained.
